Incident Overview

On February 2, 2024, a devastating fire tore through the village of Khari Basoul in Bihar's Purnia District, leaving 100 homes reduced to ash. Families were left with nothing but heartbreak and loss.

IMRC responded with compassion and urgency:

- **Phase I:** Provided essential grocery kits to over 100 affected families, sustaining them for a month.
- **Phase II (Campaign Basera):** As monsoon season approached, the need for immediate and long-term relief became critical. We started Campaign Basera, focused on rebuilding homes for the 30 most vulnerable families, offering them shelter, safety, and a chance to rebuild their lives.

Campaign Objective: To construct 30 houses for families whose homes were completely destroyed by the fire, prioritizing those most in need.

Key Milestones:

30 Homes Built: Project Completed- Shelter for approximately 150 individuals- Families have moved in to their new houses from their makeshift plastic covered tents.

Beneficiaries: Daily wage laborers, farmers, and families with young children or elderly dependents.

Community Impact: Beyond shelter, the project has restored hope, dignity, and stability in the lives of these families.




