What We Got Done Together



Relief Drives We Carried Out This Ramadan

- **Dry Grocery Kit Distribution** – Basic food supplies to help families get through the month
- **Dates Distribution** – Provided dates to families and students for breaking their fasts
- **Iftar Arrangements** – Community iftar meals organized in villages and underserved areas
- **Milk for Suhoor** – Distributed milk for families to start their fast with nourishment
- **Eid Gift Distribution** – New clothes for orphans, widows, Alimas, and men in need
- **Eid Essentials Distribution** – Items like rice, dry fruits, sugar, ghee, and milk to help families prepare for Eid

- Another young student from the same flood-affected village in Murshidabad experienced the joy of Eid after months of hardship due to displacement.





- A disabled single mother from Baruipur, raising her daughter alone, received an Eid gift that brought hope and comfort to their small family.


