







- **Over 9 million meals served during Ramadan 2025 to families in need across India.**
- Daily suhoor and iftar support provided in schools, orphanages, masjids, and street-level distribution zones.
- Family grocery kits distributed ahead of Ramadan and Eid, helping households prepare with dignity.
- Eid food boxes and sweets delivered to orphaned children and poor families, bringing joy to their celebrations.
- Qurbani meat distributed in drought-hit and remote villages during Eid al-Adha.
- **Year-round cooked meal programs run in select regions to serve the most vulnerable—widows, orphans, and laborers.**


The India Health Initiative (IHI), IMRC's flagship healthcare program, completed its 14th year of service in 2025.

Eight free medical camps were held across Telangana and Gujarat, reaching 3,153 patients. A volunteer team of 10 US based physicians provided care in cardiology, pediatrics, internal medicine, OB-GYN, pulmonology, and family medicine.



EDUCATION PROGRAM

Providing affordable education, scholarships, and support so students from underprivileged families can stay in school, learn skills, and build a better future.



Under Livelihood & Social Welfare efforts, we launched the GOAT Project in rural Rajasthan. In phase 1, we have supported 63 vulnerable families with two milk-producing goats each. The initiative aims to provide a steady source of nutrition and income, helping families move toward long-term self-reliance.

We also provide fruit and vegetable carts to individuals in need, enabling them to earn a dignified living through daily vending.

Through our Grains for Grannies initiative, IMRC distributed monthly grocery kits to 110 widows in the past six months.

These essential kits help vulnerable widows meet their basic food needs with dignity—ensuring they don't have to depend on others or go without.

Challenger Home in Hyderabad provides vulnerable children with a safe, nurturing place to live—where they receive education, nutritious meals, clothing, and personal care. In addition to our own residential facility, IMRC supports several orphanages across India by covering essential monthly expenses, ensuring that orphaned children grow up with consistent care, stability, and opportunities to learn.
